MOOSEHEART, IL, June 6

It was a moment many in Mooseheart's graduating high school Class of 2011 had been anticipating for a long time - the chance to walk across the stage in the school's Fieldhouse and receive a high school diploma. Three of this year's graduating class - Cayana Samuelson, Levi Chavez and Dawn Thomas - had been at Mooseheart for more than 13 years, a shared life of school and home life that stretched back to toddlerhood. But that trio and the entire 26 -member class was now ready to walk proudly across the stage on Saturday, June 4 and to not only move beyond Mooseheart's classrooms-- but also, in most cases, to leave their home. So when Class Valedictorian Aaron Palmer, who lived at Mooseheart just under five years before Commencement Day, stepped to the lectern just before the graduates were officially graduated, he wanted to try to recap as much as he could. 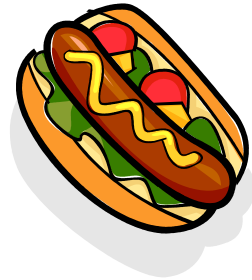
