Drink Prices:

There will be a \$.25 price increase across the board on ALL beer & liquor products. A new price sheet will be posted and placed at both bar areas reflecting increases.

Draft Beer	\$1.75
Domestic Beer	\$1.75
Imported Beer	\$2.25

Daily Book - The daily book will be increased to \$1.00 and will be capped at \$4,000.

12th Annual Three Club Golf Challenge

The 12th Annual Three Club Golf Challenge will be held at Sunset Golf Course on Sunday, June 28, starting at 7:00 a.m. using a two-man scramble format. The entry fee is \$65 per golf, which includes green fees, cart, a meal to follow at the Moose Ballroom (with beer), and eligibility for prizes, both scratch and handicap. The proceeds from this year's tournament will benefit the Elizabethtown Food Bank.

Sign-up sheets have been posted in the American Legion, VFW and Moose facilities. Golfers may select their partner and will be paired against a similar team from another club, with total scores going to determine the winner of the traveling trophy.

Golfers 60 years of age or older may use the senior tees. To enter, you must be a member of any American Legion, VFW or Moose. Guests may attend the dinner following the tournament for \$10, but are not eligible for prizes to be awarded or drawn.

If you, your organization or your company would like to sponsor a hole, the cost is \$100 per hole, which includes signage on the course and recognition in the official program.
