### **Pennsylvania Moose Convention**

#### **E-town Lodge Wins Awards At Pennsylvania Moose Convention**

Elizabethtown Moose Family Center won a number of awards and plaques at the Pennsylvania Moose Convention held at Greentree (Pittsburgh) on August 22. Included were the Moose International Superior Gold Award for family activities and the Moose International Superior Gold Award for community service. These were earned for having four consecutive quarters of "superior" ratings in those important program areas.

In addition, the Lodge won the Silver Award for Pennsylvania Moose Association Membership Booster status and the Pennsylvania Moose Association Community Service Award.

#### **Three Lodge Members Land State Moose Committee Spots**

Three members of Elizabethtown Moose Family Center 596 were appointed to committees of the Pennsylvania Moose Association for 2009-2010. They include George Germer, who will continue on the PMA Convention Committee, and Steve Krut, who will again chair the newly created Shining Star Awards Committee. Dave Donahue was appointed to chair the Loss Prevention Committee for the coming year.

#### **Flight 93 Memorial Service Expected To Draw 15,000**

A memorial service and a Blessing of the Bikes for Moose Riders is expected to draw up to 15,000 people at the Flight 93 memorial site on Friday, September 11, at Shenksville, PA. Former Secretary of State Colin Powell, former Pennsylvania Governor and National Security Director Tom Ridge are expected to address the gathering, as well as Moose International Director General Bill Airey.

The Moose Riders will leave Windber Lodge by 7 a.m. and will ride to Old Bedford Village for the blessing of the motorcycles following the service, before heading to the Bedford Moose Lodge for a dinner and Pilgrim robing ceremony.

All members of the Moose are invited and strongly encouraged to attend and participate in this memorial program. Directions to the memorial site will be posted in the Windber, Bedford and Elizabethtown Moose Lodges. Please wear your Flight 93 memorial ties, hats, shirts or other Moose clothing to the site. The Moose has donated more than \$250,000 toward the memorial site, the largest amount of any non-profit fraternity and will be donating memorial ties to all families of the victims and heroes of Flight 93. This is a very special service that is in reality close to us in distance and close to our hearts. We hope you can join us for this tribute! Services at the memorial site are expected to start at 10 a.m.

We will be starting family movies again in September on one Sunday of every month.

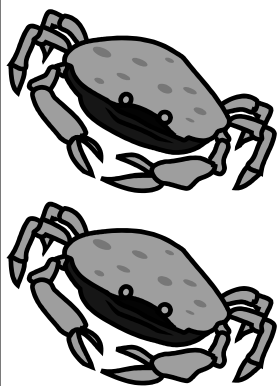
Watch for the dates and times of them in the Lodge to be posted. Popcorn is provided.
