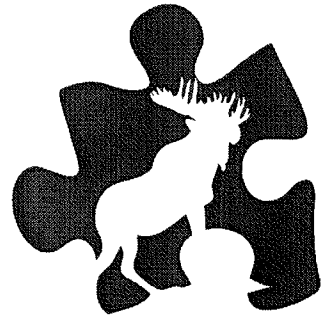

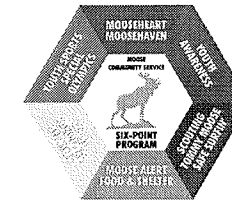

If you want to see the Lodge change and grow then we need your help and input.

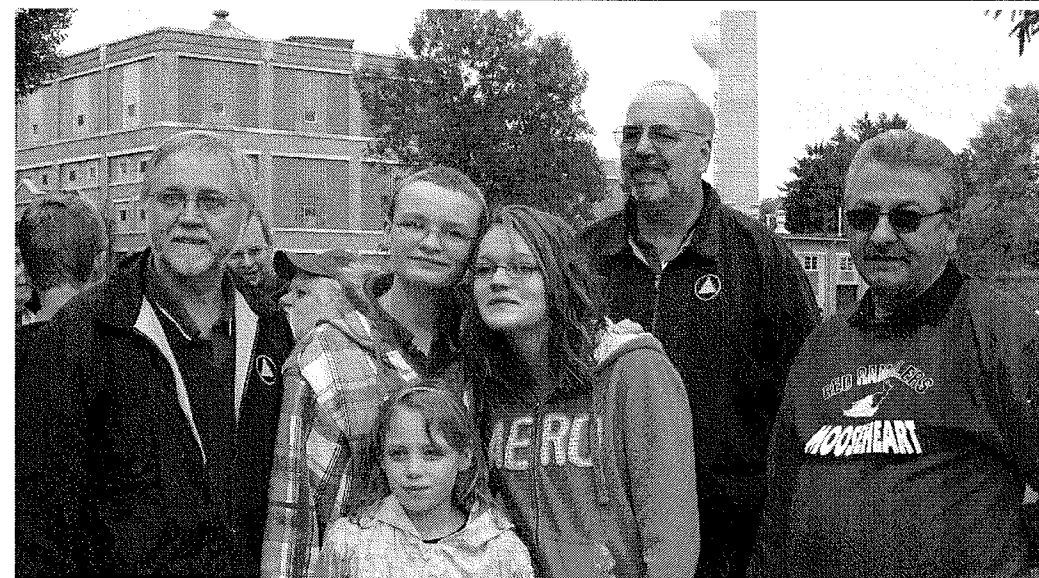
From the Desk of Administrator, Bill Lennert:

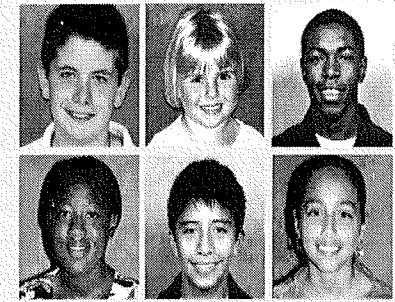

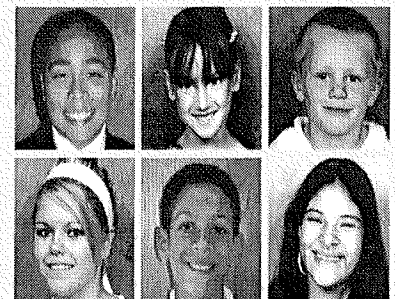

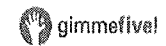

**MOOSE CHARITIES' GIMME FIVE! CAMPAIGN**
