ADMINISTRATOR'S MESSAGE

Brothers,

As many of you know Charles (Chuck) Buczeskie has retired from the Administrator position and the Board of Officers has named me as Acting Administrator. To become Administrator I need to complete several required Moose International courses and then be voted upon by the Lodge. The officers and I want to personally thank Chuck for his many years of devoted service to the Lodge and we hope that you will do the same when you see him in the Social Quarters.

You may have read in your Moose magazine that Moose International has raised their assessment on each member. For the men, \$16 is currently kept from your \$30 dues payment. Beginning September 30th, the assessment level increases to \$28, leaving the Lodge with just \$2 from each member's dues. What's more, the announcement indicated that for the next five years the assessment will continue to increase at the rate of 2 additional dollars per year. As you might guess the Board of Officers will be discussing a dues increase at future meetings.

I also want you to know that at the direction of the House Committee I am currently reviewing Social Quarters drink prices. It has been about 2 years since prices were last raised and during that time we have absorbed several increases from the liquor store and our beverage distributors. In that same period, we have also incurred increases in employee wages and benefits and fuel oil and utility rate increases. So you should expect to see some Social Quarters price increases in the coming months too.

While I don't enjoy bringing you news that it will likely cost you more to be a member of the Moose and that visits to the Lodge Social Quarters may become a bit more expensive, you need to know what the board is facing before changes occur. I encourage all male LOOM members to be part of the discussions on these issues and to voice their opinions by actively attending the General Membership Meetings held at 6:00 PM on the 3rd and 4th Tuesdays of each month. These meetings are always open to LOOM members and it is the time and place where concerns should be raised. In addition, when you attend you have a right to vote on any recommendation the Board or the House Committee brings to the floor.

I look forward to working with all of you in the coming months and hope to see you at the Lodge.

NICHOLAS RYAN OVER FOUNDATION

Members of the Carlisle Moose Family Center #761, Skip and Cris Over, have just donated a unit called AED (Automated External Defibrillator) to our lodge. They have come in and donated their time to train all of our employees and some of the Moose Officers and WOTM Officers. They also gave us CPR training. The unit now is out in the Social Quarters.

Seven years ago, Skip and Cris lost their son, Nicholas, to sudden cardiac arrest due to a rare heart disorder. Nick was only 20 years old. An autopsy showed that Nick had heart and lung abnormalities and it was determined that he suffered from Arrhythmogenic Right Ventricular Dysplasia.

ARVD is estimated to affect one in 5,000 people. They founded the, Nicholas Ryan Over Foundation, to promote awareness of ARVD and other life-threatening arrhythmias. The foundation was designed to raise funding to purchase AEDs for area schools in need of them and to fund research for ARVD

Since its inception in 2002 the foundation has purchased 39 AED'S and raised about \$58,000. Some of the schools that have received AEDs from the foundation include Bellaire, Crestview, Hamilton, LeTort, Mooreland, Mt Holly Springs, North Dickinson Elementary schools, St Patrick School, Boiling Springs High School, and Carlisle High School.

We thank the Overs for their time and dedication to the donation of this AED unit to our lodge. We know that we all can breathe a lot easier knowing that this is in our Social Quarters.
