Moose Family Center Qualified Guest Definition

Three classifications of a qualified guest

1. Prospective Member (male or female). 1st visit you are considered a guest. 2nd visit you are considered a prospective member. 3rd visit you must join or leave.
2. Immediate Family (see below)
3. Lady friend of a good standing lodge member or a gentleman friend of a good standing chapter member.

Moose Immediate Family Definition

Along with the IRS definition of "immediate family" we must remember what the private policy states (General Laws - pg 143): If the immediate family member comes in with a family member of the same gender and are the age of 21 or older, they are then considered a prospective member and no longer an immediate family member. For instance, if a Lodge brother brings in his son who just turned 21 he is no longer considered a family member, he is now a prospective member, however, if a Chapter member brings in the same son who just turned 21 he can come in as often as he wishes with that chapter member. The Chapter member cannot sign a male up as a member and vice versa a Lodge member cannot sign a female up as a member.
