# 2012 PENNSYLVANIA MOOSE ASSOC. MENS & WOMENS BOWLING TOURNAMENT

1. **The tournament is open to both men & women. There is not a separate division for women. Men and women may bowl on the same team or as doubles partners.** All bowlers must be members in good standing of the Loyal Order of Moose or Women of the Moose at the time of bowling in the tournament. Lodge or Chapter certification is required.
2. All bowlers must be sanctioned by the USBC.
3. All averages used in this tournament shall be based on 21 games or more.
4. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his average. Any bowler who submits a false average shall forfeit any and all prize money.
5. A team which does not have a full line-up, will not receive any score for an absentee bowler
6. Any team or individual in this tournament failing to appear on the lanes when scheduled to bowl shall forfeit their entry unless the tournament chairman finds sufficient reason to grant a postponement.
7. No entry money will be refunded if it is found that a team or individual have failed to comply with all the rules and regulations governing this tournament.
8. The tournament chairman and tournament committee shall have full power as to the acceptance of any substitutes offered for any event, supported by proper affidavit. Each substitute must bowl under their name and only at the properly scheduled time.
9. All remittance must be made in the form of a check or money order and made payable to Danville Moose. There will be a \$40.00 charge for any returned checks.
10. **NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS PAID IN FULL.** All bowlers will bowl as listed on entry forms
11. Use highest USBC average of 2010-11 season. If you do not have a 2010-11 average, use highest average as of January 1, 2012 for 21 games or more. Those without a sanctioned average must use a 220 tournament average. Summer league averages are not accepted. Tournament will be conducted on a handicap basis. Each bowler will get 90% of the difference between his average and 220.
12. Singles will be bowled first, and then doubles. There will normally be six (6) bowlers scheduled to each pair of lanes in singles & doubles.
13. To participate in singles & doubles you must enter both events.
14. USBC Rule 319A-2 will be applied which in brief says at the time of entry, the entrant has a current season's average for 21 games or more which is 10 points or more higher than the previous seasons average, the bowler must use their current average for entry in the tournament. USBC Rule 319A-3 states in part, failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game bowled in a series shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher.
15. USBC Rule 309C: at least one prize for each 10 entries or major fraction thereof.
16. A bowler is not eligible to compete more than once in each event of this tournament with the following exception. Members of Danville Moose Lodge or Chapter only will be allowed to bowl more than once for out of town teams in order to fill vacancies, and will qualify for prize money.
17. **NO CARRY-IN FOOD OR BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED.**
18. Any rules not covered above will be covered by the United States Bowling Congress.
19. The tournament manager reserves the right to re-rate any entrant prior to bowling for reasons other than those set forth in rule #2. In case of lane breakdown causing undue delay, the tournament director has the right to move bowlers to vacant lanes. Bowlers moving will receive no practice frames if they have already started competition.
